Community Need Program Fund Distribution Process

The process is carried out by volunteers and is used by the United Way of Monroe/Lenawee Counties to determine how the campaign dollars are distributed to member agency human service programs. Through this careful evaluation, the United Way of Monroe / Lenawee Counties maintains its commitment of integrity to the donors while providing needed human service programs in the community.

How Does It Work?

Three separate panels of volunteers are recruited, one for each of the target areas of care shown on the left. Agencies submit program proposals, including budgets, for the appropriate panel online. The panel researches the community need in their particular area of service, studies the proposals and interviews the agencies included in their panel. The panel formulates recommendations for funding to the United Way Board of Directors.
