

To promote affordable childcare, to support substance abuse recovery, to support homeless families and youth, to promote grief support, to provide senior services.

To support cancer patients, to promote an ample blood supply, to provide legal services for seniors and low income families, to promote independent living for people with disabilities, to provide transportation services.

The **United Way** advocates for all people throughout our communities. For example, the 21-Day Equity Challenge leads us on a journey that focuses on diversity, equity and inclusion. ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) research demonstrates how many individuals, often referred to as "the working poor", are above current poverty levels, but cannot afford basic living needs to survive. Students explore career choices through the building trades summer camp. Legislation is important to everyone. Advocacy is crucial. Policy changes that affect our health, the economy, education, and equality impact poverty.
